WAKE UP AMERICA

BEFORE IT IS TO LATE!

Do you remember what happened after the terrorists attack our country on September 11, 2001? People who had been taking God's name in vain, began talking about praying to God, at least for awhile. And for a short time, America came together, as we did when the Japanese attack Pearl Harbor. Remember the words of the Japanese Admiral after the Pearl Harbor sneak attack? He said, "...I fear we have awaken a sleeping giant." Yes, America had another wake up call, when the terrorists attack us, but what happened shortly afterward? – **The giant went back to sleep!**

Who would deny that America's moral foundation is now in the process of eroding away? When the great principles of truth and righteousness, which have for generations upheld our society, are removed, will not the results be disastrous? As great as the Roman empire came to be in the history of the world, greater was its fall after persecuting the church of Christ (Dan. 2:36-45)!
